MPORTANT NOTICES AND AGREEMENTS Parents, guardians and students who are 18 and over should initial after each statement. This ensures that each statement is read and understood. Forms that are not initialed will NOT be accepted.
All Kealakehe High School students must be passing CEPA with a year grade of at least 85% at the end of the FHIRD quarter.
CEPA grades for first quarter will be pulled on Tuesday, October 27 (after the "I" deadline). Whatever grade shows on this day will be used.

Guests may not be older than 20 years old. Dance attendees still in school must be in high school and at least 13 years old.
Online sales will be done from Monday, September 21 to Friday, September 25. Cash and money order sales w be done in the SAC office during wiki and lunch from Tuesday, September 22 to Thursday, September 24 ONLY. Checks are not accepted!
Students wishing to purchase their tickets using cash MUST have a completed dance agreement at the time of ticket purchase.
Students who purchase their tickets online MUST submit a completed dance agreement one week after the purchase of their tickets.
Refunds will not be given. For any reason (including, but not limited to, not passing CEPA)
Kealakehe students and their guests must complete the guest agreement and are required to abide by all school rules and the terms of the agreement. Anyone exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified and no refunds will be given.
Students may be checked for illegal or controlled substances prior to entry to the dance area. Students will be required to check large bags at the door. Administrators, security officers and chaperones will determine what size bags should be checked.
ANY vehicle, including limousines, can be searched at any time. PASSENGERS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE AND GIVEN CONSEQUENCES FOR ANY ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE IN THE VEHICLE.
Parents, family members or others are asked not to rent rooms for students as this often leads to impropriate behavior.
Students and guests understand that Kealakehe High School may stop the dance at any time if they feel the safety of any guest is in danger or if illegal substances are found in the event. Students and guest understand that refunds will not be issued should an event be cancelled due to such circumstances.
Trading or selling of tickets is not allowed. Tickets are non-transferable.
Attendees who switch wristbands with each other will be asked to leave the event immediately and will face disciplinary actions. Parents or guardians of such individuals will be required to come pick up offenders should they be forced to leave the event.
All students and guests must present their student ID or government issued ID at the registration table. Guests must arrive to the dance with their Kealakehe host student.
Students who violate the terms of this agreement are subject to suspension from school and loss of privileges to participate in any co-curricular and extracurricular activities including athletics, senior activities, and possibly commencement exercises. The Kealakehe High student and his/her parent are responsible for the guest's behavior.
