IMPORTANT NOTICES AND AGREEMENTS

Parents, guardians and students who are 18 and over should initial after each statement. This ensures that each statement is read and understood. Forms that are not initialed will NOT be accepted.

_____ All Kealakehe High School students must be passing CEPA with a year grade of at least 85% at the end of the THIRD quarter.

_____ Tickets for all attendees are \$85. Seniors are allowed up to two guests.

_____ Guests may not be older than 20 years old. Dance attendees still in school must be in high school and at least 13 years old.

_____ Online sales will be held from Tuesday, January 17 to Friday, January 20. Cash and money order sales will be done on the SAC office before school, during wiki and lunch from Wednesday, January 18 and Thursday, January 19 ONLY. Checks are not accepted!

_____ Students wishing to purchase their tickets using cash MUST have a completed dance agreement at the time of ticket purchase.

_____ Students who purchase their tickets online MUST submit a completed dance agreement one week after the purchase of their tickets.

_____ Refunds will not be given. For any reason (including, but not limited to, not passing CEPA)

_____ Kealakehe students and their guests must complete the guest agreement and are required to abide by all school rules and the terms of the agreement. Anyone exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified and no refunds will be given.

_____ Students may be checked for illegal or controlled substances prior to entry to the dance area. Students will be required to check large bags at the door. Administrators, security officers and chaperones will determine what size bags should be checked.

_____ ANY vehicle, including limousines, can be searched at any time. PASSENGERS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE AND GIVEN CONSEQUENCES FOR ANY ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE IN THE VEHICLE.

_____ Parents, family members or others are asked not to rent rooms for students as this often leads to inappropriate behavior.

_____ Students and guests understand that Kealakehe High School may stop the dance at any time if they feel the safety of any guest is in danger or if illegal substances are found in the event. Students and guest understand that refunds will not be issued should an event be cancelled due to such circumstances.

_____ ***Trading or selling of tickets are not allowed. Tickets are non-transferable.***

_____ Attendees who switch wristbands with each other will be asked to leave the event immediately and will face disciplinary actions. Parents or guardians of such individuals will be required to come pick up offenders should they be forced to leave the event.

_____ All students and guests must present their student ID or government issued ID at the registration table. Guests must arrive to the dance with their Kealakehe host student.

_____ Students who violate the terms of this agreement are subject to suspension from school and loss of privileges to participate in any co-curricular and extracurricular activities including athletics, senior activities, and possibly commencement exercises. The Kealakehe High student and his/her parent are responsible for the guest's behavior.

_____ Guests understand the hotel may impose a charge for parking of vehicles and that this fee is not included in the ticket price.

_____ Dancing Guidelines (applies on and off the dance floor):

- Lewd and lascivious dancing will result in a student being asked to leave the event and will be ineligible to attend the next dance. Parents will be notified.
- No straddling legs
- No bending over
- No front to back touching / grinding
- No touching of breasts, buttocks, or genitals
- No "making out" (no overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection)
- Hands on waists or shoulders only

_____ Administrators may remove any attendee from the dance floor and/or event should they deem their dancing and actions inappropriate. No refunds will be given should this happen.

_____ Students who violate the dress standard will not be allowed to enter the event.

_____ An administrator may deny entrance to any attendee if he or she determines the items worn are inappropriate for a school event.

_____ Once students are admitted into the dance, if they alter their attire in such a way as to make it violate the specified dress code standards, they will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified, and they will not be permitted to attend the next dance.

Ladies:

- Strapless/spaghetti straps are allowed
- Dress/skirts must be at least two inches from mid thigh
- Slits no higher than two inches from mid-thigh
- Backless to waist is permitted – below waist is not permitted (opposite your belly button)
- No garters or other exposed lingerie/undergarments
- No part of the dress should be sheer or see-through
- No excessively low cut dresses or tops, cleavage must not be exposed
- No bare midriffs

Gentlemen:

- Tuxedo or full suit with formal jacket and tie required
- Shirts must have sleeves
- Shirts must remain on
- Dress pants or slacks, no jeans or corduroy (of any color, black included)
- No bandanas, chains, or canes
- No sunglasses
- Dress shoes are required
