Dance Agreement

In order to promote a healthy, safe, enjoyable evening for all students, the following procedures will be in place for this dance. All parents and students must read, understand, and sign this agreement. Kealakehe High School encourages families to discuss these rules together with their students and to copy this document for future reference.

This is a dance agreement for students who are currently attending Kealakehe High School. This agreement must be filled out completely. *Incomplete or late forms will NOT be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.*

- 1. All guests must be UNDER the age of 21 and middle school students may not attend. Kealakehe students and their guests must complete the guest agreement and are required to abide by all school rules and the terms of the agreement. Anyone exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified, and no refunds will be given.
- 2. Changing your guest must be done no later than one week from the dance.
- 3. All students will be checked for illegal or controlled substances prior to entry to the dance area. Any student who refuses to comply will be denied entry. Students will be required to check their bags at the door. Cameras are permitted.
- 4. ANY vehicle, including limousines, can be searched at any time. PASSENGERS WILL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE AND GIVEN CONSEQUENCES FOR ANY ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE IN THE VEHICLE.
- 5. Dancing Guidelines (applies on and off the dance floor):
 - Lewd and lascivious dancing such as "freaking" will result in a student being asked to leave the event and will be ineligible to attend the next dance. Parents will be notified.
 - No straddling legs
 - No bending over
 - No front to back touching / grinding
 - No touching of breasts, buttocks, or genitals
 - No "making out" (no overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection)
 - Hands on waists or shoulders only
- 6. Dress Code for Formal or Semi Formal Dances:

Ladies:

- Strapless/spaghetti straps are allowed
- Dress/skirts must be at least fingertip length
- Slits no higher than fingertip length
- Backless to waist is permitted below waist is not permitted (opposite your belly button)
- No garters or other exposed lingerie/undergarments
- No sheer/see-through dresses and no see-through sides or bare sides
- No excessively low cut dresses or tops
- No bare midriffs

Gentlemen:

- Collared shirt and tie or tuxedo
- Shirts must have sleeves
- Shirts must remain on
- Dress pants or slacks, no jeans (of any color, black included)
- No baseball hats, bandanas, chains, or canes
- No tennis shoes (of any color, black included)
- No sunglasses

Please note: If you are unsure if your attire meets these dress standards, please check see the Student Activities Coordinator prior to the day of the event. Students not meeting these standards will not be admitted into the event and parents will be notified.

Once students are admitted into the dance, if they alter their attire in such a way as to make it violate the specified dress code standards, they will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified, and they will not be permitted to attend the next dance.

- 7. All students and guests must present their student ID or government issued ID at the registration table. Guests must arrive to the dance with their Kealakehe host student.
- 8. Students removed or denied entry will not be given refunds.
- 9. Students who violate the terms of this agreement are subject to suspension from school and loss of privileges to participate in any co-curricular and extracurricular activities including athletics, senior activities, and possibly commencement exercises. The KHS student and his/her parent are responsible for the guest's behavior.
- 10. If a student is not picked up within a half hour of the end of the dance, he or she will not be allowed to attend the next dance.
- 11. Guests who are students at Kealakehe High School must also clear all obligations and be passing citizenship in order to attend the Ball and must have this form turned in with the appropriate signatures.
- 12. Guests understand the hotel may impose a charge for parking of vehicles and that this fee is not included in the ticket price.
- 13. No refunds of any kind will be given because counts will have already been submitted and favors purchased. This includes not being a citizen in good standing, as adequate time has been allowed to make up points. No refunds will be given to students who have not turned in permission forms.
- 14. Students and guests understand that Kealakehe High School may stop the dance at any time if they feel the safety of any guest is in danger or if illegal substances are found in the event. Students and guest understand that refunds will not be issued should an event be cancelled due to such circumstances.
- 15. Trading or selling of tickets is not allowed. Tickets are non-transferable.
- 16. Students or guests who switch wristbands with each other will be asked to leave the event immediately and will face disciplinary actions. Parents or guardians of such individuals will be required to come pick up offenders should they be forced to leave the event.

I understand that this dance is a school-related event, and all school rules apply. I agree to abide by the dance behavior rules set forth in this agreement including the dress code and dance rules. I AGREE TO REMAIN TOBACCO, DRUG, AND ALCOHOL FREE FOR THIS EVENT. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT MY FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES SO WILL RESULT IN MY INELIGIBILITY FOR ALL CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, SENIOR ACTIVITIES, AND POSSIBLY COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES, AS WELL AS SUSPENSION AND POSSIBLE EXPULSION. I understand the consequences for any inappropriate behavior. I have read the rules and agree to abide by them.
