- I will turn this completed petition in, including the attached questions to Mr. Young no later than 1:00PM on Thursday, February 20. DO NOT LEAVE THIS PETITION IN ANY BOX. HAND SUBMIT ONLY!
- Elections will be held on *Friday, April 2* during wiki and lunch.
- If I am elected, I am willing to fulfill the responsibilities as described in the Constitution
  of Kealakehe High School. I understand that failure to do so may result in the removal
  from office.
- If awarded the position of Hawaii State Student Council, I must attend at least four State Student Council meetings that will be held in Honolulu. Meetings may be held during breaks or state holidays. Transportation will be provided, including airfare, free of charge.
- I will enroll on Mr. Young's leadership course. The period this course will be offered is unknown and will be scheduled once the results of the election are released (this is done to minimize course conflicts). I must stay in the class the entire year. Should I drop the course, I will have to vacate my position.
- I understand that my responsibilities begin at the end of this school year (meetings will be held during the summer) and run through the next school year.
- Transportation to and from meetings outside of the school day will be minimal but will be my responsibility.
- I will maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA. If my GPA falls below this minimum, I will be put on academic probation and subject to grade checks. If my grades do not improve, I may be relieved of my duties.
- If elected I am willing to attend leadership training camps and workshops. Some of the financial costs will be my responsibility.
- I have no outstanding dues, fines, uniforms, or other financial obligations.
- Should I incur either a "Class A" or "Class B" (see "Chapter 19") offense I will immediately be removed from my position and will not be able to run for any future position.

## **Election Rules**

### **CAMPAIGNING STARTS AT 7:30AM ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 21**

## Each ASB candidate will be limited to:

- One banner (2' x 6')
- 5 poster board signs (24" x 36")
- 25 flyers to post. (8 ½" x 11")

Blue tape will be provided. Only blue painter's tape may be used to hang posters.

During voting, all candidates must stay at least 20 yards away from the polling area (except for when candidate is casting their own vote).

Any candidate or candidate team members/friends deemed in violation of any of election guidelines or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in:

1<sup>st</sup> violation—suspension of campaign privileges (includes bio information on website.)
 2<sup>nd</sup> violation—disqualification from election and possible school discipline

These violations can include improper posting of materials, covering up previously posted material, the vandalizing or tearing down of campaign postings or any other conduct determined to be detracting from a fair and sanctified election.

#### Clarifications

- No campaigning in class or classrooms (no posters, no voting with phones, no speaking to people, no passing out flyers during class time)
- Posters must be hung within your reach by you (no asking staff members for assistance, no climbing on the roof, no ladders at school)
- Posters with claims/promises that are outside of the ASB's control will not be approved

No bribery or handouts of any kind (no candy, no coupons, etc.).
